

WYVER LANE MONTHLY REPORT JUNE 2013

Highlights include: Great Crested Grebe, Egyptian Goose, Red Kite, Peregrine and Spotted Flycatcher.

Maximum counts this month include a site rare Great-crested Grebe on 20th, 4 Cormorants on 13th, 3 Grey Herons on 31st, 35 Greylag Geese on 9th, 86 Canada Geese on 13th, an Egyptian Goose on 13th, a Shelduck on 3rd, 7 Gadwall on 3rd, 6 Teal on 18th, 40 Mallards on 3rd, a Mandarin on 6th and 11th, 10 Tufted Ducks on 22nd, and 6 redhead Goosanders on 10th.

Raptors this month include a Red Kite on 3rd, 4th and 6th, Sparrowhawk almost daily, 4 Buzzards on 3rd and 4th, 2 Kestrels on 6th and a Peregrine on 3rd.

3 Oystercatchers on 3rd, 13 Lapwings on 14th, 2 Curlew on 10th and 3 on 27th, 85 Black-headed Gulls on 25th, a Common Gull on 18th, 51 Lesser Black-backed Gulls on 27th, a Herring Gull on 11th, 25th and 27th, 2 Common Terns on 21st, 4 Stock Doves on 11th, 25 Swifts on 10th, 25 House Martins on 10th, 13 Wrens on 6th, 3 Redstarts on 18th, 2 Mistle Thrush on 6th, 4 Sedge Warblers on 3rd, 5 Whitethroats on 3rd, a Garden Warbler on 6th, 4 Blackcaps on 3rd and 6th, 4 Chiffchaffs on 3rd and 6th, a Spotted Flycatcher on 14th, 13 Long-tailed Tits on 14th, 21 Starlings on 4th, a Linnet on 6th and 8 Reed Buntings on 25th.
